Food Skills BC (FSBC) is a six-week employment program for youth looking for training, skills, and experience in food to find the direction and confidence they need to fuel their futures.

Who is eligible?

- A young adult between the ages of 16 and 29
- A Canadian citizen, permanent resident or protected person (under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act, S.C. 2001, c. 27) legally entitled to work in Canada
- Living in British Columbia
- Unemployed or precariously employed
- Not receiving duplicative financial supports from another provincially or federally funded labour market program
